The undersigned is directed to invite proposals in specified format from faculty members for establishment of Centre of Excellence under TEQIP-II in addition to the four areas specified in the earlier notice dated 26th November 2012 in this regard.

The faculty members are requested to submit their proposals in the areas other than the following areas:


- Green Science and Technology
- Bio-medical Engineering and Technology
- Renewable Energy
- Smart System and Instrumentation
- Water Resource and Environmental Engineering
- Advanced Materials
- Integrated Assessment of Infrastructure System and Disaster Management

These areas are earmarked for UCT-CU and BESU by SPFU, West Bengal.

The objective of this scheme under TEQIP-II is to support establishment of Centres of Excellence for Engineering and Technology based collaborative and multi-disciplinary research within specific thematic areas of regional or national importance. The updated concept paper for this along with the specified format may be found in the website of TEQIP-II. The other relevant documents for TEQIP-II like Project Implementation Plan can be downloaded from NPIU website (<http://www.npiu.nic.in/dmf.htm>).

The final proposals are to be submitted to TEQIP Cell within 11:00 a.m. on 10th December, 2012. The proposals will be presented (for 10 minutes) by the coordinators of the Centres proposed (or his/her nominee) in front of a committee chaired by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. The committee will select the proposals to be sent to State Project Facilitation Unit/National Project Implementation Unit for further selection. The presentation will be held in Committee Room-II at 12:30 p.m. on 10th December, 2012.

Please note that Architecture and Pharmacy are out of the scope of TEQIP. The proposals with a basic theme of these two fields will not be considered for selection. However, the faculty members of these areas can participate in the groups pursuing research in other engineering and technology based areas.
