Considered a deputation from Jadavpur University Officers Association regarding various issues.

No. 228 Edn(U) dt. 08-03-2001 with appropriate designation as per University Circular Vide No. REC/188/2005 dt. 08-08-2005 based on E.C. Resolution No. 95 dt. 12-04-2005.
- 2. All the vacant posts of the officers are to be filled up immediately for smooth running of the University.
- 3. Officers of all levels are being harassed while discharging their respective duties due to shortage of officers and lack of uniform appropriate directive from the authorities. We demand not only filing up of the vacant officer posts but also creating and appointing following new officers for smooth functioning of the University.

 - c. System Administrator
 - d. Deputy Controller of Examinations
 - e. Secretary ISLM

DEPUTATION NO. 3:

Considered a deputation from Trinamool Chhatra Parishad regarding various issues.

Contents of the Deputation:

On behalf of Trinamool Chatra Parishad -Jadavpur University unit we are here to bring to your notice two subjects which must be addressed by the authority immediately. First of all green zone is an area within the university which is serene with greenery and is home to different species including birds and other creatures. It also has a statue of our Lt Vice Chancellor who was brutally murdered by the naxals during the late 20 th century. But it has come to our notice that this area has been recently used by the arts faculty

students union for conducting fest. They have used loud speakers and smoke sprays and also have created chaos in the whole area which have threatened the ecology and have caused massive environmental damage. Now the question which comes to our mind is who gave them permission to do so? And if nobody gave them permission then how did they carry out this whole segment.

Secondly, if you take a walk around the campus you will find that it's full of stalls which are selling different types of jewelaries, clothes and food items. few days ago in a similar occasion when stalls were set up in the campus the authority along with our vice chancellor made sure that they don't get to sit there and sell their articles. We knew that Jadavpur University is space which promotes equality and equal treatment towards all irrespective of their social, religious or political background but these incidents are forcing us to believe otherwise. We hope that You will look into the matter and take necessary steps within 24hrs and if the authority fails to do so then we will think that the authority is bias towards a particular students organisation and their ideology and it will force us to take further action regarding this matter.

DEPUTATION NO. 4:

Considered a deputation from FETSU regarding hosting of Students' Union Elections.

No hard copy of demands were received.

DEPUTATION NO. 5:

Considered a deputation from AFSU regarding various issues.

Contents of the Deputation:

Despite continuous demands of the students of the Arts Faculty to conduct the AFSU elections for the smooth functioning of exchanges between the authority and the student body, the negligence of any actionable proceedings on your part in starkly visible. This has put both the functioning of our union as well as our trust on you has fruitful mediators with the government.

We demand immediate notification for conducting the AFSU elections, failing which we would have to assume the autonomy of JU under attack and respond in accordance to the severity of the situation.

Other demands:

- The placement cell should be revived at the earliest.
- The toilet inside the campus should be kept clean and hygienic.
- We should have at least two genders neutral toilets.
- The toilets and water dispensers should be made available for 24 hours a day.
- The health centre should be revived at the earliest.
- We should have a subsidised medical pharmacy inside the campus.
- The Central Library should remain open for 24 hours and the numbers of books should increase.
- Departmental libraries must include more books on vernacular languages.
- Should start a language cell immediately.
- Should hold all stakeholders meeting regarding the matters of students' safety and security inside the campus.

DEPUTATION NO. 6:

Considered a deputation from AISA regarding various issues.

Contents of the Deputation:

- 1. Jadavpur University witnessed it's last election in the month of february, 2020. Since then after the reopening of campuses pan India, the University authorities are yet to announce dates for the election. Moreover the authorities promised a date after 12th of January for a tripartite meeting, which they are yet to respond to. This negligence towards the students and stakeholders will not be met calmly. We demand immediate declaration of the dates for union election and a tripartite meeting regarding the former.
- 2. Most of us are aware regarding the language discrepancies that has been a big issue among many students, some of who had to resort to dropout from their courses. Cell yet again and the commencement of a Communicative English course for each and every department in ARTS Faculty.
- 3. We have also come to know that the departments of Linguistics, Sociology, History, Film Studies and Journalism and mass Communication are having vacancies pertaining to Professors. These departments are running inadequately with less number of teaching staff. We demand the vacant seats be filled as soon as possible without further delay.
- 4. We demand an increment in the number of PhD seats in every department of the ARTS Faculty.
- 5. At this moment the University is equipped with only a single ambulance. We demand more ambulance with better facilities.
- 6. We also demand a subsidized medical shop in the campus.

DEPUTATION NO. 7:

Considered a deputation from Jadavpur University Contractor's Workers' Union regarding various issues.

Contents of the Deputation:

- ১। যাদবপুর বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় কন্ত্র্যাক্টরস ওয়ার্কার্স ইউনিয়নের সম্পাদক শ্রী বলরাম সাহার বিগত মাসে অনৈতিকভাবে যে মাইনে কেটে নেওয়া হয়েছে তা ত্রিপাক্ষিক বৈঠকের সিদ্ধান্তকে অমান্য করেও এতদিন আটকে রাখা হয়েছে। আমরা দাবী জানাচ্ছি আগামী দুইদিনের মধ্যে অবিলম্বে এই বকেয়া টাকা মিটিয়ে দেওয়ার জন্যে। এই প্রসঙ্গেই আমরা এও বলে রাখতে চাই যে ক্যাম্পাসে কর্মরত আমাদের নেতৃত্বসহ অন্যান্য কর্মীদের উপর যে অনৈতিক চাপ সৃষ্টি করা হচ্ছে এবং যেভাবে তাদের উপর মিথ্যে অভিযোগ দায়ের করা হচ্ছে তা রাজনৈতিক মদতপুষ্ট। অবিলম্বে যদি সমস্ত সেক্টরে সুপারভাইসার নিয়োগ করা নাহয় এবং দায়িত্বের সুষ্ঠু বণ্টন না করা হয় তাহলে আমরা বাধ্য হবো বৃহত্তর আন্দোলন সংগঠিত করতে।
- ২। আমরা এও লক্ষ্য করছি যে বিভিন্ন উপায়ে আমাদের এরিয়ার ও ওভার টাইমের টাকা সঠিকভাবে দেওয়া হচ্ছে না। আমরা দাবী জানাচ্ছি অবিলম্বে প্রাপ্য টাকা দেওয়ার জন্যে।

Contents of the Letter from Dr. Mondal dated 09.11.2022:

With due respect, I would like to state that I joined as an Associate Professor in the Department of International Relations, Jadavpur University on 22.01.2019. After 3 years of my completion of the service as an Associate Professor, I applied for my next promotion for the post of Professor under CAS, which would have been effective from 22.01.2022. After completing the CAS promotional viva, I came to know through the Registrar's letter that the effective date of my promotion will be the date of successful viva voce of my first Ph.D scholar.

Important to mention here that my First Ph.D scholar Soumen Debnath was registered in Jadavpur University on 05.02.2019. I became his Supervisor in the month of June 2019. He submitted his thesis on 25.07.2022 and his successful Ph.D viva voce was done on 01.11.2022.

Further, I also mention that I served my previous College from 01.06.2005 to 21.01.2019 and there was no scope of guiding Ph.D scholar. After joining Jadavpur University, I started supervising Ph.D scholars and Soumen Debnath is my first Ph.D scholar.

The due date of my promotion, from Associate to Professor post under CAS, is 22.01.2022, but as per letter of the Registrar, the effective promotional date is 01.11.2022.

Under these circumstances, I humbly request you to consider my promotion date with effect from the due date i.e., 22.01.2022.
